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### Chapter I. Organisation.



## Article 8. General Prescriptions.

All the prescriptions for • the general safety discipline • signaling wall procedures • suspending & resuming a race • safety car procedure • application of the regulations • Protests & Appeals will follow the rules from the F.I.A. International Sporting Code prescriptions in compliance with the 2021 prescriptions of the RACB

The Clerk of the Course must inflict the penalties set out in the sporting regulations. For all cases not provided in the regulations, the will hand over a report to the Panel of the Stewards of the Meeting, that will apply the regulations provided by the International Sporting Code (article 12) or National Sporting Code. - the amount of the Right to Protest is fixed by RACB Sport & Motorsport Ireland : € 500,00 Right of Appeal:
- the amount of the National Right of Appeal is (RACB Sport & Motorsport Ireland): € 2.000,00
- the amount of the International Right of Appeal is (FIA) : € 6.000,00
